Assessment Criteria

Under the terms of the LI Regulations (2.5.2), every candidate for admission into the grade of Academic Fellow must "demonstrate their contribution to the development and understanding of Landscape Practice in some or all of its forms, through teaching and/or research in higher education", and "demonstrate that their contribution to teaching and/or research has been outstanding and substantial."

The Landscape Institute's Fellowship Admissions Board requires evidence for the applicant meeting the following criteria:

- 1. Experience and performance in teaching or research, which should have been substantial and of outstanding quality.
- 2. Contribution to the understanding of the landscape, through advancing theory, philosophy, pedagogy or standards, external examinerships, participation in subject review or academic peer review; again, this should have been substantial.
- 3. Personal qualities and integrity, particularly qualities which are outstanding.

As a guidance to applicants, the Fellowship Admissions Board normally expect applicants to have a minimum of 5 years post AMLI experience to achieve the calibre expected for recommendation for Academic Fellowship. However, applications from members with less than 5 years post AMLI experience who feel they meet the assessment criteria outlined above are still welcome to apply for potential consideration by the Fellowship Admissions Board. Please also note that any application is not an automatic award to Fellowship, but an application for consideration.
