PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This should be a narrative of 200-500 words, telling the story of the scheme – its history, development, context etc.

It should cover themes such as (but not limited to):

- Inception of the scheme – how did the need for the work arise?
 - What it's intended to achieve/has achieved
 - Design process
 - Approaches to consultation and participation
 - Intended users
 - Social and environmental context
 - Broader strategic/policy objectives
 - Any particular issues or considerations that arose at any stage, and how these were addressed
 - Anything else of special interest about the site, location, scheme or approach to the job
